Day 1: Welcome to Chile, August 21

Arrival and welcome cocktail

Your great experience in Chile begins in the city of Santiago, a modern and sophisticated metropolis embraced by the majestic Andes. After checking in at the hotel, we will close the day with an exclusive welcome cocktail at Restaurante Ofelia, the perfect setting to toast to the adventure that is about to begin.

- Meals: Welcome cocktail.
- Accommodation: Hotel Pullman Vitacura.

Day 2: Bound for the Atacama Oasis, August 22

Exploring the mystical Valle de la Luna

In the morning, we will transfer to the airport to fly to Calama, where our private service will drive us to the magical oasis of San Pedro de Atacama. In the afternoon, experience one of the most iconic landscapes on the planet: the Valle de la Luna, in the Cordillera de la Sal. We will explore the great dune, the natural amphitheater, and the enigmatic sculptures of "Las Tres Marías". To crown the day, we will ascend to the famous Mirador Piedra del Coyote (Kari) to contemplate a moving sunset in front of the imposing Cordillera de los Andes, accompanied by a cocktail specially prepared to make this moment unforgettable.

- Meals: Breakfast, lunch and Sunset Cocktail.
- Accommodation: Hotel Noi Casa Atacama or Hotel Our Habitas.



Day 3: Adventure through the Valleys, August 23

Garganta del Diablo and Valle del Arcoíris

We will enjoy a full day exploring the amazing geological contrasts of Atacama. The journey begins by entering the spectacular Garganta del Diablo, one of the most impressive natural formations around San Pedro de Atacama, where we will take a hike through canyons and ravines that reveal sublime desert landscapes and panoramic views in the middle of a captivating silence. After enjoying a refreshing box lunch in nature, we will continue toward the Cordillera de Domeyko to marvel at the Valle del Arcoíris, where millennia of erosion have sculpted hills dyed in vibrant red, green, and white tones. The circuit includes a visit to the petroglyphs of Hierbas Buenas, a journey into the historical legacy of the area, closing the afternoon with an exclusive cocktail while contemplating the chromatic wealth of the valley.

- Meals: Breakfast, Box Lunch, and Cocktail.
- Accommodation: Hotel Noi Casa Atacama or Hotel Our Habitas.

Day 4: Deep Altiplano and Cosmos, August 24

Piedras Rojas, Lagunas Altiplánicas, and Astronomical Night

We begin our journey south toward the Sico border crossing, enjoying a unique breakfast in the middle of a serene tamarugo forest. We will continue toward Piedras Rojas to walk along the shores of the Salar de Aguas Calientes III, a breathtaking landscape where the reddish rocks contrast intensely with the white of the salt and the intense blue of the lagoons. Then, we will ascend to an altitude of over 4,000 meters to let ourselves be marveled by the sacred lagoons Miscanti and Miñiques, protected by volcanoes and Andean fauna. After an included lunch, we will return to the village to prepare for the evening. At sunset, we will experience a guided Astronomical Tour, far from light pollution. Divided into three stations (Andean Worldview, Photography, and Star Gazing with a telescope), we will understand the secrets of the southern hemisphere accompanied by a comforting coffee break.

- Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Nighttime Coffee Break.
- Accommodation: Hotel Noi Casa Atacama or Hotel Our Habitas.



Day 5: The Salt Effect, August 25

Laguna Cejar, Ojos del Salar, and Water Mirrors

We will have a free morning to connect with the unhurried rhythm of the village. In the afternoon, we will enter the Salar de Atacama to visit Laguna Piedra (Cejar sector), famous for its extremely high salt concentration that allows you to float naturally and effortlessly in its turquoise waters. We will continue toward Laguna Tebenquinche, an extensive mirror of water where the Andean volcanoes reflect, creating an optical spectacle second to none, and we will visit the Ojos del Salar, two deep circular pools in the middle of the desert that yield perfect photos of the Cordillera de los Andes, while enjoying an exquisite farewell cocktail.

- Meals: Breakfast, lunch and Cocktail.
- Accommodation: Hotel Noi Casa Atacama or Hotel Our Habitas.

Day 6: The Awakening of the Earth, August 26

Géiseres del Tatio and Return to the Capital

We will start the journey at dawn toward El Tatio, the largest geothermal field in the southern hemisphere, situated at over 4,200 meters above sea level. As the sun rises, we will witness the peak activity of more than 80 geysers in full boil. After this mystical experience, we will enjoy a country breakfast in a wetland (bofedal) surrounded by local birdlife. On the descent, we will stop at the Putana wetland—with views of the active volcano of the same name—and at the Machuca wetland, an oasis ideal for spotting flamingos. Finally, we will take our private transfer to the Calama Airport to fly back to Santiago.

- Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Accommodation: Hotel Pullman Vitacura.



Day 7: Strategic Connections, August 27

Business Roundtable and Networking with the Chilean Industry

We will dedicate this day to strengthening bonds and connecting with the forefront of the local tourism industry. After breakfast at Restaurante Ofelia, we will begin the first session of the business roundtable in the Salón Madrid of the Hotel Pullman. We will enjoy an executive lunch to continue with the second session of professional meetings, concluding the afternoon with a dynamic networking cocktail, ideal for consolidating strategic alliances.

- Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
- Accommodation: Hotel Pullman Vitacura.

Day 8: Tradition and Terroir in the Valle del Maipo, August 28

Premium Wine Tourism Experience and Farewell

We will have breakfast at Restaurante Ofelia and check out to transfer to Viña Cousiño Macul, a true jewel of Chilean wine tourism founded in 1856 and the only 19th-century winery that remains in the hands of the founding family. Here, we will experience a sophisticated vertical wine tasting, a private tour of its historic cellars, and a lunch with a premium pairing experience that pays tribute to the identity of its terroir. Upon completion, we will proceed to the Santiago airport to take the international return flight home, closing an unforgettable expedition through Chile.

- Meals: Breakfast and Gourmet Pairing Lunch.
