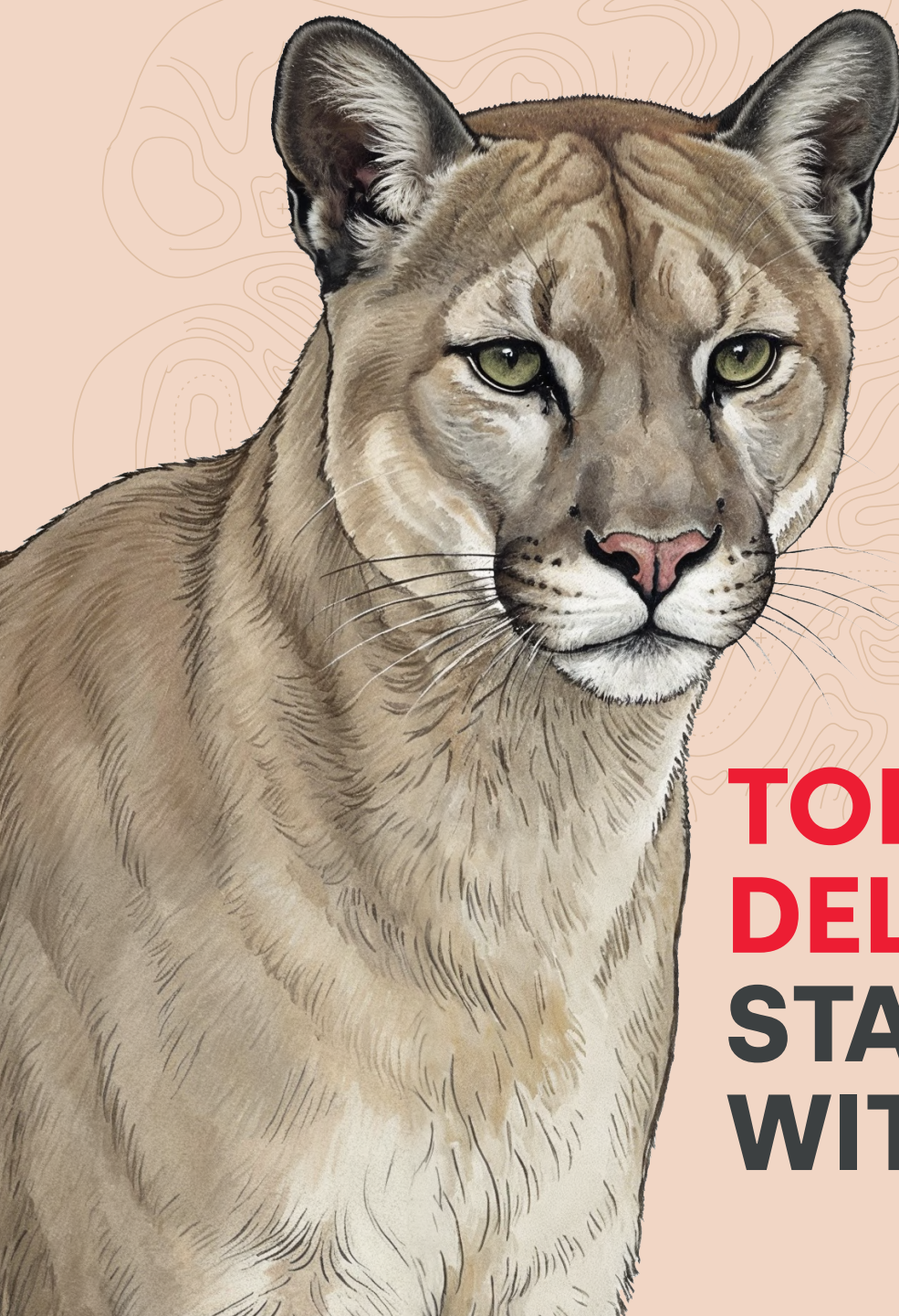

Day 1: Welcome to Chile, August 21

Arrival and welcome cocktail

Arrival in the city of Santiago de Chile, a modern and sophisticated city embraced by the majestic Andes, where your great experience in Chile will begin. We will check into the hotel to close the day with a welcome cocktail at Restaurante Ofelia (inside the hotel).

- Meals: Welcome cocktail.
- Accommodation: Hotel Pullman Vitacura.

Day 2: August 22

The Gateway to Patagonia: Wind, Light, and Welcome

Your journey begins upon landing at the Puerto Natales Airport, where the horizon expands under the famous wind and the unique light that define this mythical territory. Following a comfortable private transfer to the hotel, you will enjoy an afternoon of rest and disconnection.

The Night Experience: In the evening, we will transfer to the Hotel Río Rubens for an experiential dinner. Each dish will be a contemporary tribute to native products and regional culture.



Day 3: August 23

The Pioneering Soul and First Glimpses of the Paine Massif

We will dedicate the day to exploring Torres del Paine National Park, one of the world's premier natural icons, intertwining scenic drives with strategic stops to understand the southern geography and biodiversity.

- **Estancia Tradition (Morning):** We will stop at an authentic Patagonian estancia with half a century of history. We will live the Wool Tour —from the work of the sheepdogs to the artisanal spinning mill— and enjoy a traditional Asado de Cordero al Palo (spit-roasted lamb) served buffet-style.
- **Scenic Route Through the Eighth Wonder (Afternoon):** We will continue our journey through Torres del Paine National Park, stopping at its most iconic landmarks:

Lago Sarmiento Viewpoint: Famous for its exclusive white calcareous formations on the shore and its imposing geological view.

Laguna Amarga: The control point where you will capture the perfect postcard of the Towers reflected in the water.

Paine Waterfall: A pause to feel the untamed force of the river and the wind.

Salto Grande & Cuernos del Paine: A short hike will lead us to the great waterfall that connects lakes Nordenskjöld and Pehoé, opening a privileged panoramic view of the Cuernos del Paine.

Lake Pehoé: Famous for its intense turquoise color due to glacial sediments.

The day concludes with check-in and rest at the Hotel Lago Grey at sunset, when the Patagonian light completely transforms the park's landscape.



Day 4: August 24

Grey Lake and Glacier Experience – Hiking, Navigation, and Ice

Millennial ice will be the core axis of this day, designed to combine physical challenge, safety, and ultimate contemplation.

- Navigation and Grandeur (Morning): We will begin with an interpretative walk along the dark sands of Grey Beach before boarding the Grey III catamaran. We will navigate among deep blue icebergs until we approach the colossal face of the glacier.
- Active Adventure with Bigfoot Patagonia (Afternoon): We will take exploration to the next level by paddling in a kayak among floating icebergs and embarking on an ice trekking expedition on the glacier itself. Equipped with crampons, we will traverse crevasses, meltwater rivers, and blue ice caves.
- The Closing: We will return on the vessel to enjoy a comforting brunch at the hotel and conclude with a sophisticated gourmet dinner at the same venue.

Day 5: August 25

The King of the Park: The Puma Safari

We will venture into the Magellanic steppe during the first hours of the day, when Patagonia becomes quietest and the wildlife awakens.

- The Silent Search (Morning): Alongside the expert trackers from ISO 100 Outdoor, we will experience a photographic puma safari under strict principles of responsible tourism. We will learn to read the signs of the landscape: the tension in the guanaco herds, the circular flight of the condor, or the trail of fresh paw prints. Encountering the great predator, elegantly camouflaged within the vegetation, is a brief and awe-inspiring moment that justifies the entire journey.
- Last Postcard and Return (Afternoon): We will take a final tour of the park's most magical viewpoints before returning to Puerto Natales. We will say goodbye over a dinner specially designed around the great Magallanic delicacies.



Day 6: August 26

Return to Santiago

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, a private transfer will take you back to Puerto Natales airport to board your return flight, concluding this magnificent southern voyage.

Day 7: Business Roundtable, August 27

Connect with the Chilean tourism industry

We will have breakfast at Restaurante Ofelia, and then begin the first session of the business roundtable in the Salón Madrid of the Pullman hotel. We will have an executive lunch to then continue with the second session of the business roundtable and finish with a networking cocktail.

- Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
- Accommodation: Hotel Pullman Vitacura.

Day 8: Wine Tourism Experience, August 28

Enjoy the best of Valle del Maipo

We will have breakfast at Restaurante Ofelia and check out of the hotel, to then transfer to Viña Cousiño Macul, located in the city of Santiago. Here we will experience a vertical wine tasting, followed by a tour of the cellars and a lunch with a premium pairing experience. Viña Cousiño Macul is a jewel of Chilean wine tourism. Founded in 1856, it is the only 19th-century winery in Chile that remains in the hands of its founders, now in its sixth generation. This continuity translates into a passion for quality and a deep respect for the identity of its terroir.

Finally, we will transfer to the Santiago airport to return home and bring our adventure through Chile to a close.

- Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
